

CAMPING PACKING CHECK LIST



SLEEPING COMFORTABLY

A tent (with stakes, guy lines and a hammer)
Sleeping bags (with optional liners)
Sleeping pads / Air mattresses (inc. repair kit)
Pillows (Bring your own pillow and use in the car for little snoozes on the road!)

You should probably also have:

Flashlight or Lanterns (save your phone battery!)
Multi-tool or knife
Extra blanket (useful in the car)

OTHER USEFUL ITEMS

Toilet paper
Insect repellent
Hand sanitizer
First-aid kit

COOKING

A Stove & a windscreen
Fuel
Matches / lighter
A Frying pan
Cook pots & Pot grabber
A Strainer
A Portable coffee maker (of course!)
Mugs/cups
A Cutting Board
Plates, bowls, mixing bowls...
Cutlery, Utensils, Paring knife, Spatula...

Other Useful cooking tools to have at hand:

Food-storage containers
Bottle opener/corkscrew, can opener
Biodegradable soap
Pot scrubber/sponge
Towels & napkins
Foil
Trash bags

CRITERIAS

Brings things that are:

Light and small. If stackable, foldable or easy to pack... it's even better.
Sturdy enough to endure packing and unpacking.
Adequate to the environment you will be in.
Reusable. Ditch the plastic!
Easy to use in multiple ways.

Don't bring 'just in case' items. Plan ahead!!
